Virtual tasting coupons

The visitors will get a «connected» card, pre-charged with the number of virtual coupons of their choice. Kiosks will be equipped with mobile scanners to receive the payments. Recharge stations are available as last year at the couponneries.

Beers/Food: 400 products (beers, spirits, ciders, food...)
98 breweries, distilleries, meaderies, food concessions and other partners
34 outside of Quebec breweries with more than 110 beers (Warning: very limited supplies)

- **Glass :** Tastings will be served exclusively in Mondial de la bière glasses from the 1994 to 2022 editions. Visitors will be able to obtain their glass on site.
The Mondial's glasses from 1994 to 2022 are either made of glass or are reusable cups. They are designed for responsible consumption and 5% of the sales revenue from the glasses is donated to Fondation Rivières.
- **Importations/ 34 outside of Québec breweries :** Germany, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Estonia, United States, Ireland...
